- Communicate effectively with others, verbal and written (must respond to emails)
- Ability to achieve targeted goals
- Identify and assess related and unrelated (prior) auto damage and set clear expectations on timeline for repairs and outcome
- Inspect vehicles and write estimates, documenting claim related information and making decisions
  consistent with claims standards and local laws
- Prepare estimates in an accurate and timely fashion, in accordance with manufacturer and company
  guidelines, as to provide the production department and the insurance companies with a detailed
  "blueprint" of the repairs,
- Communicating with insurance personnel
- Review and determine if any supplement requests are needed; communicate supplements to Customer Service Representative and insurance companies on the same business day as written, and continuously pursue supplemental approval by insurance company
- If additional work is needed, explain the details to the Customer Service Representative, including the additional cost and time consideration and document properly on the repair order
- Maintain and execute a timely schedule before, during and after completion of repairs
- Make total loss determinations and establish total loss evaluations
- Stay connected with Customer Service Representatives, providing contemporaneous updates on repair process, parts delays, insurance approvals, and supplemental repair estimates, so they have current and accurate information to communicate to customer
- Input estimate and corresponding notes/paperwork into CCC One database
- Ensuring that all administrative processes are handled in a timely and correctly
- Keep production manager, Customer Service Representative, and other team members informed of all problems and potential problems involving repairs, customers and equipment
- Stay up-to-date on technical and vehicle performance information and resources
