### Position Overview/Job Summary:

A **Detailer – Automotive Cleaning Technician** is responsible for prepping, washing, and detailing customer's automobiles after collision repair, and also providing other services the team may need assistance with, while demonstrating a friendly, accommodating, cheerful attitude. Auto detailing is far more than just a car wash; the intricate cleaning involves shampooing upholstery, wiping down all surfaces, and even meticulously cleaning tiny crevices in the dash components. This is an entry level position that often leads to rapid advancement within the organization as we prioritize promoting from within.

### Duties & Responsibilities:

- Responsible for performing a thorough detailing and cleaning of all vehicles, interior and exterior, prior to final delivery to the customer
- Responsible for performing a pre-wash on vehicles prior to the actual repair process beginning and may also wash vehicles during estimating process in order to identify all damage
- Operating buffers, steamers, hoses, vacuums, and other equipment
- Provide support to the collision center by shuttling customers and vehicles
- Manage, order and re-stock detailing supplies
- Visually inspect every vehicle for flaws in the repaired area(s)
- Replace minor/superficial parts and accessories, and/or tighten or adjust loose parts when directed
- Responsible for keeping shop clean and clear of clutter, performing various duties to maintain a clean and safe environment
- Attend/collaborate with team during production and/or training meetings
- Perform other duties as assigned

### Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Valid driver's license required
- Open to applicants who do not have a high school diploma/GED
- Previous paint/body shop or detailing experience a plus, but willing to train the right applicant
- Ability to distinguish small imperfections in your work, such as streaks/smudges on windows or painted surfaces, areas of missed vacuuming, etc.
- Ability to meet physical demands of position, including standing, bending, stooping and moving for extended periods of time
- Good communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to keep up and succeed in a fast-paced working environment
- Maintains a well-groomed, professional appearance
- Availability to work weekends, evenings and holidays at direction of management

### Working Conditions:

Position is based on a normal collision body shop environment, and work will be in non-climate-controlled conditions; wet and/or humid conditions. Position requires physical activity such as reaching below and above shoulder level, kneeling, squatting, bending, stooping and moving for extended periods of time, and occasional lifting and carrying objects over 50 lbs. Required to wear protective equipment when necessary. \_
